

ARCSA CONCORSO D'ELEGANZA – SUNDAY 18 SEPTEMBER 2022

The Alfa Romeo Club of South Africa, its sponsors, organisers and judges wish to extend a warm welcome to participants and visitors to their Annual Concorso d'Eleganza, to be held at Queens Street Venue (opposite Flamingo Shopping Centre) in Modderfontein.

All Alfa Romeo owners are welcome at this prestigious event and will be entitled to enter their Alfa in one of the categories of display, subject to the Rules of entry in the category selected. These rules are set out as follows:

Concours D'Etat and D'Elegance:

Only fully paid-up members of A.R.C.S.A. entering either of these categories shall be awarded floating trophies. A nonmember may enter and will be recognized if they come in the top three places. However, this recognition will not include the awarding of a floating trophy. Please note that you can become a member by signing up on the day. **Please note that authenticity is a critical criterion for D'Etat. If the car has parts that are not authentic those parts will be zero rated on the score sheet, so it might be better entered in D'Elegance.**

Regulations:

- 1) Cars are to be in place by **08:00**.
- 2) Judging will commence at 09:00.
- 3) The Left front wheel must be removed, the car being supported on a solid structure, such as an axle stand or a steel or wooden solid base. Judges need to be able to get under the car in safety, and for this reason jacks will not be acceptable.
- 4) Alfa Spider's **must** have either the soft top erected, or a hard top in place. An open topped car will not qualify for judging.
- 5) Battery covers, where applicable, must be removed.
- 6) Spare wheel covers, where applicable, must be removed.
- 7) Tools, handbooks, manuals etc. may be displayed in front of the car on suitable ground cover.
- 8) Trophies, past awards, certificates etc. are permitted as part of the display.
- 9) All items of a personal nature, not relevant to the car, e.g. cooler bags, clothing, cleaning equipment etc. must be removed from the stand before judging commences at 09:00.
- 10) Mirrors may be placed under or next to the car to facilitate viewing.
- 11) Score sheets are to be completed with **all** relevant detail filled in and placed under the windscreen wiper. For D'Etat entries, authenticity documents are to be attached to the score sheet.
- 12) Only cars older than 10 years may enter D'Etat (i.e. pre 2011 models) D'Elegance entries may be for any age of car.
- 13) The judge's decision is final. Any interference or argument with any of the judges may result in penalties or disgualification.
- 14) If there are any queries they are to be directed to the Chief Judge.
- 15) It is a requirement that the car engine be run for the Judging in both D'Etat and D'Elegance. All entrants therefore must be available to start the car during judging.

NOTE: Please ensure that all vehicles entered are in neutral for the duration of the show. This is to avoid a vehicle being started in gear whilst one wheel is jacked up, and possibly causing injury to someone.

Concours Pre Millennium Cars:

Open to all Alfa owners with an Alfa manufactured prior to 31 December 1999, irrespective of whether the owner is a member of A.R.C.S.A. or not. Judging will be limited to the exterior only of the car on display.

Regulations:

- 1) Cars are to be in place by **08:00.**
- 2) Judging will commence at 09:00.
- 3) The bonnet and boot should be left closed, however if you wish to leave them open you may, but the condition within will not be judged.
- 4) Alfa Spider's **must** have either the soft top erected, or a hard top in place. An open topped car will not qualify for judging.
- 5) Score sheets are to be completed with **all** relevant detail filled in and placed under the windscreen wiper.
- 6) An additional 5 bonus points will be awarded for each 5 years of age attained, provided that the year of manufacture is entered on the score sheet by the entrant. If this is blank no points will be awarded.
- 7) Five Bonus points will be awarded to entrants who display an A.R.C.S.A. Club sticker on their car.
- 8) The judge's decision is final. Any interference or argument with any of the judges may result in penalties or disqualification.
- 9) If there are any queries they are to be directed to the Chief Judge.

Concours Post Millennium:

Open to all Alfa owners with an Alfa manufactured after 1 January 2000, irrespective of whether the owner is a member of A.R.C.S.A. or not. Judging for this class will include the interior of the car as well as the exterior, but not the engine bay or underbody.

Regulations:

- 1) Cars are to be in place by **08:00**.
- 2) Judging will commence at 09:00.
- 3) Alfa Spider's **must** have either the soft top erected, or a hard top in place. An open topped car will not qualify for judging.
- 4) Score sheets are to be completed with **all** relevant detail filled in, and placed under the windscreen wiper.
- 5) An additional 5 bonus points will be awarded for each 5 years of age attained, plus an additional 5 bonus points for each multiple of 50000kms travelled, provided that the year of manufacture and the total kms travelled are entered on the score sheet by the entrant. If this is blank no points will be awarded.
- 6) Five Bonus points will be awarded to entrants who display an A.R.C.S.A. Club sticker on their car.
- 7) The judge's decision is final. Any interference or argument with any of the judges may result in penalties or disqualification.
- 8) If there are any queries they are to be directed to the Chief Judge.

Concours Rally & Racing Plus Modifieds:

Open to all owners of Alfa Rally or Racing cars of any age, plus any modified Alfa Romeo, irrespective of whether the owner is a member of A.R.C.S.A. or not. This includes members of other Alfa Clubs. Please note that evidence of participation in competitive events for Race & Rally will earn additional Bonus Points.

Regulations:

- 1) Cars are to be in place by 08:00.
- 2) Judging will commence at 09:00.
- 3) Score sheets are to be completed with **all** relevant detail filled in, and placed under the windscreen wiper, or in a suitable place where the judge can find it easily and quickly.
- 4) Five Bonus points will be awarded to entrants who display an A.R.C.S.A. Club sticker on their car.
- 5) Ten Bonus Points will be awarded to cars where there is evidence of the car having participated in at least two events during 2020/21.
- 6) The judge's decision is final. Any interference or argument with any of the judges may result in penalties or disqualification.
- 7) If there are any queries they are to be directed to the Chief Judge.
