The 2024 Rally theme is: "on the footsteps of the Stupor Mundi", an itinerary to discover the legacy of Frederick II of Swabia and evidences of the Norman Swabian domination, in the sunny lands of Southern Italy, across Puglia and Basilicata Regions, where the sea breeze blows over the infinite expanses of olive trees and vineyards, the blinding white lime covers the small houses, the ancient villages are a treasure chest of popular traditions lost elsewhere.

Ostuni

Chic Ostuni shines like a pearly white tiara, extending across three hills with the magnificent gem of a cathedral as its sparkling centrepiece. It's the end of the trulli region and the beginning of Salento.



Manduria

The land of Primitivo di Manduria, the famous red wine with strength, richness, character and complexity of aromas, whose grapes come from ancient vines cultivated as "saplings", which grow on the "red earth", on which the sea breezes blow.



Alberobello

With over 1500 Trulli, the typical limestone houses of the Itria Valley, extraordinary examples of rural construction in dry stone slabs, dating back to prehistory and still used in this region, with whitewashed walls and a conical roof in set stones

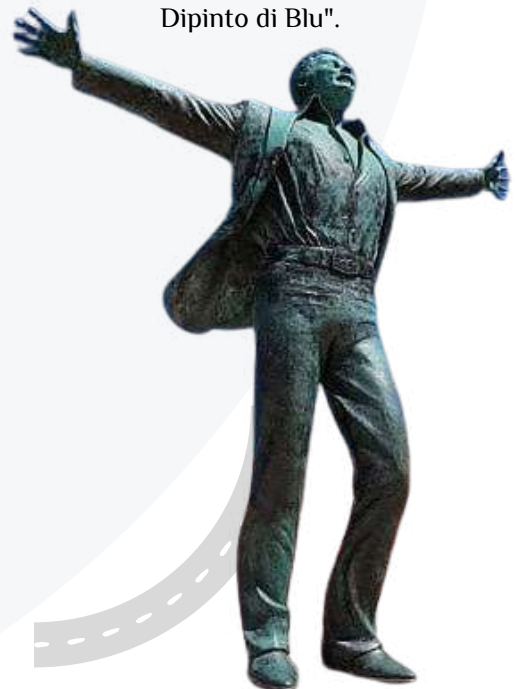


Itria Valley, Manduria

- Expanses of olive trees in the Itria Valley, the UNESCO Heritage sites of Alberobello, Cisternino and Martina Franca
- Castel del Monte, masterpiece of medieval architecture between the Muslim world and classical antiquity.

- Rhythm of the traditional local dances: "pizzica" and "taranta"
- Salento with Baroque Buildings and Coastline

Polignano a Mare

Dozens of Grottoes, inhabited since the Pleistocene era, and the cliff full of natural coves, from which **Domenico Modugno** began to VOLARE towards the world, to the tune of "Nel Blu Dipinto di Blu".



Nardò

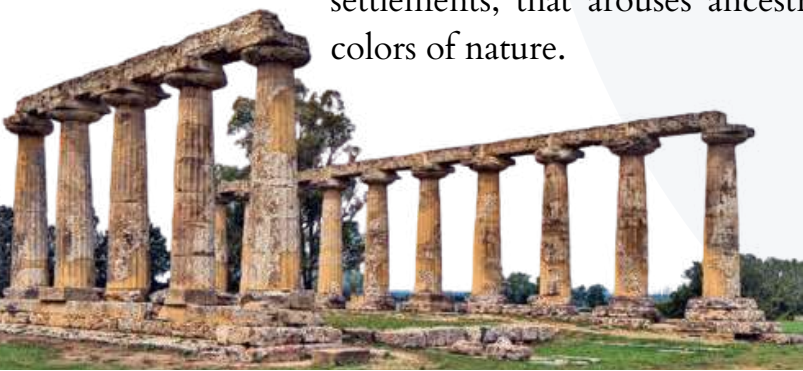
Nardò, the ancient Neretum, a jewel with a timeless atmosphere, with the **baroque historic center**, surrounded by lush greenery, and stretching out towards the sea with crystal clear water, full of coastal towers, museums, and ancient farms.





THE ANCESTRAL CHARM OF PRIMARY COLORS

The ancient “**Lucania**”, where the passage of man has left its mark since prehistoric times, it is enriched by an incredible artistic heritage. Rich in scenery, unique architectural works, views of incomparable charm, like the **Murgia plateau**, with over 150 **frescoed rock churches** with different architecture and iconography, a sample of intersection of the **Greek Byzantine culture** with the Latin world. The never-boring panorama which ranges from the **Lucanian Dolomites** to **Matera**, the world’s oldest continuously-inhabited human settlements, that arouses ancestral sensations with its primary colors of nature.



BASICATA

On the Road



Montescaglioso

A "Jewel of Italy" since 2012, this town is famous for its four local monastic institutions, the best known being the **Benedictine Abbey of San Michele**.



Metaponto

In the heart of Magna Graecia, on the boundless Ionian coast, where **Pythagoras** settled, stand the remains of the ancient Greek city, with the imposing and fascinating **Palatine Tables**, twelve Doric style columns, remains of the Temple of Hera.



Miglionico

This exquisite historic village was built around the majestic **Castello del Malconsiglio**, the site of a famous conspiracy against Ferdinand I, King of Naples, in 1485.



Matera, the Gravine Canyons and the Ghost Towns

- "Sassi" of Matera (UNESCO Heritage), the world's third-longest continuously inhabited human settlement
- Canyons of the Gravine
- Archaeological sites of Grumentum and Metaponto
- The Little Dolomites of Lucania

Dolomiti Lucane

Between the two hamlets of **Castelmezzano** and **Pietrapertosa**, perched on towering sandstone peaks, known as the **Little Dolomites**, we will have an «angelic» experience, and walk on the 586 meters of the longest Tibetan bridge in the world.



Aliano & Craco

The ghost villages of **Aliano and Craco**, perched on the Calanchi, the infinite expanse of clay undulating in the sun as far as the eye can see, similar to Cappadocia, rich agricultural cities at the Normans time, today a peasant Pompeii of the 19th century.
